

# Welcome to Lang Lang Foreshore Caravan Park



## General Information

### Arrival and Departure

Sites are available from 11.00am and accommodation from 2.00pm. Check out time is 10.00am.

### Office Hours

Office hours are 9.00am – 5.00pm Monday to Saturday and 9.00am – 11.00am Sunday (these hours may vary).  
After hours: 0416 201 461 or 0409 939 110.

### Water

The park uses bore water on camp sites and the amenities block and is not suitable to drink. A rainwater tank for your drinking water is situated next to the bbq with the tap on the roadside fence in front of it. All grey water is to be collected in a container and disposed of in a responsible manner.

### Laundry & BBQ

Coin operated washing machines, a dryer and bbq are available for guest use. A biodegradable non antibacterial cleaning liquid or powder is to be used. Please refer to list of suitable products in the laundry. Washing powder available for sale at reception.

### Private Property

Management does not accept any liability for loss or damage to any car, caravan, tent or lost property in the park. Please make sure you secure all valuables. Lost property can be handed in at the office and will be held for 2 weeks.

### Cleanliness

Please ensure campsites and accommodation are left clean and tidy on departure.

### Garbage

Wheelie bins are situated at the main amenities block. Cans and bottles to be put in bins provided. Food scraps and cigarette butts to be wrapped before putting in bins. Cardboard boxes to be broken up and no hard rubbish to be dumped in bins, laundry, pavilion or any other part of the park.

### Pets

Dogs are permitted on campsites only as long as they are on a leash at all times and their droppings to be picked up and disposed of properly. If justifiable complaint is made about your dog the manager has the authority to ask the offender to leave.

### Visitors

All visitors must come to the office on arrival to sign in and must vacate the park by 11:00 p.m.

### Rules and Regulations

- A speed limit of not more than 10kph must be observed at all times. If you exceed this it will be brought to your attention. If you exceed it again you will be denied vehicle access.
- There is strictly no excessive noise, drunkenness, offensive language or behaviour at any time. The noise curfew is between 11:00 p.m. & 7:00 a.m.
- As part of your fee you may have 1 car and/or 1 boat on your site. Any extra cars are to be parked at the amenities car park.
- Children under the age of 7 years old must be accompanied by an adult whilst in the amenities block.
- Persons under the age of 18 years must have parental supervision at all times while in the park.
- Bicycles and scooters may be used during daylight hours only. Park entry and amenities areas are to be kept clear and helmets are to be worn at all times.
- Use of generators is prohibited.
- Cleaning of fish and boats are to be done at the boat ramp.

### Important Safety Requirements

- In accordance with CFA regulations no portable gas bbq's and solid fuel camp ovens and appliances such as gas cooktops, lights or fridges are not to be used in the open, in a tent, annexe or tent like trailer on days of total fire ban.
- Open fires are not permitted at any time. You can have a fire out of fire season as long as it is in a contained vessel, off the ground, the area 3 metres around and above is cleared completely of flammable material, there is sufficient water in case of emergency and is completely extinguished before leaving.
- All vans must have fire extinguishers, a fire blanket and a working smoke alarm. Leads must be of a rating of 15amps and tagged.
- All tents must have a 10 litre container of water or a fire extinguisher. Leads must be of a rating of 15amps and tagged.
- A space of 2 metres between your neighbouring camp sites is required for CFA access and to avoid the spread of fire.
- All vans must be sited with drawbar facing the road and gas bottles in date and secured.
- Pegs or stakes may be driven into the ground to a depth of 400mm to avoid underground electricity and water services.
- In case of emergency contact 000
- The emergency plan can be found throughout the amenities block and the pavilion. Please familiarise yourself with the plan.
