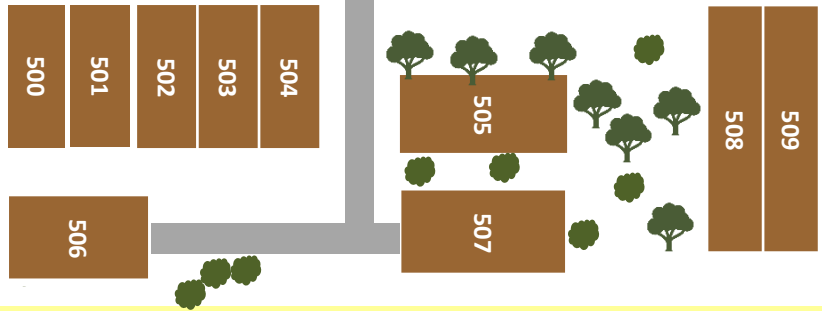

### EMERGENCIES AND EVACUATIONS

3 short blasts repeated on the emergency siren indicates an emergency exists

1. Ensure moveable caravans are kept in a moveable state.
2. Follow the instructions of the Management staff.
3. Turn off all power & gas to your site.
4. Close all windows, doors & hatches.
5. Gather your family & pets. If you are unable to locate them quickly please advise staff.
6. Walk to the evacuation area as directed by the park evacuation plan or Management staff.
7. DO NOT attempt to move caravans or vehicles
8. Follow directions by emergency personnel or Management staff during & after the evacuation.

### IMPORTANT SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- All vans must be sited with drawbar facing the road and gas bottles in date and secured.
- Pegs or stakes may be driven into the ground to a maximum depth of 400mm to avoid underground electricity and water services.
- The emergency plan can be found throughout the amenities block and the pavilion. Please familiarise yourself with the plan.
- In accordance with CFA regulations, no portable gas BBQ's or solid fuel camp ovens, or appliances (including gas cooktops, lights, fridges) are to be used in the open, in a tent, annexe or tent like trailer on days of total fire ban.
- Camp Fires are permitted (subject to fire restrictions). They must be in a contained vessel and off the ground. An area of 3 metres around and above must be cleared completely of flammable material. A campfire must never to be left unattended by a responsible adult. You must have sufficient water in case of emergency. All camp fires must be completely extinguished before leaving and when no responsible adult is in attendance
- All vans must have fire extinguishers, a fire blanket and a working smoke alarm. Leads must be of a rating of 15amps and tagged
- All tents must have a 10-litre container of water or a fire extinguisher. Leads must be of a rating of 15amps and tagged.
- A space of 2 metres between your neighbouring camp sites is required for CFA access and to avoid the spread of fire.

***Boatshed / Annual vans are private property, we ask you respect the owner's space. Park guests are not permitted to use their decking or socialise, within 2 metres of the boatsheds or annual vans.***
